Zimri	Song/Music "HeartSong"
Son of Salu	born of Valuation/Weighing
Head of a father's house among the Simeonites	Dominant Motivator derived from the Tribe of Hearing --2nd son after Seeing (Reuben)

Cozbi	Deceit "Deceivabelle"
Daughter of Zur	born of Stoney "Stoney the Stubborn"
Head of a father's house in Midian	Dominant Motivator derived from the House of Strife
